How to be a stargazer

What is a stargazer?

A stargazer is a person who looks at the night sky and can tell which star is which.

### **What you will need to be a stargazer!**

A torch with red cellophane over it because it does not interfere with the sky at night.

Always make notes of what stars you see!

A compass

You can buy different binoculars in different sizes and powers for instance 8x30. The first number tells you by how many times the object will be magnified and the second is the measurement in mm across the front lenses. A minimum of 8x30 would give good results but you can see a lot from your naked eye.
